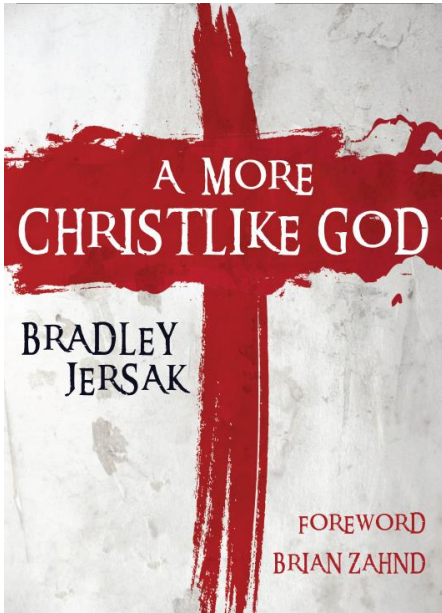


Grace Camp Seattle 2016
